SCHOOL OPINION SURVEY

The suite of School Opinion Surveys are undertaken each year by the Department of Education and Training to obtain opinion information from parents/caregivers, students and school staff. The surveys are designed to help schools identify what they do well and how they can improve. Responses are confidential. Opinions on the school, student learning and student well-being are sought from a parent/caregiver in all families and a sample of students from each state school.

A form has been sent home to each family with a unique code for you to log on and complete the survey at home. The library will be available for parents from 2-3pm on Thursday and Friday afternoons if you wish to access our computers to complete the online survey. The online surveys will be open from the 31st July until 25th August.

LATE ARRIVALS/ATTENDANCE

To acknowledge those students who have excellent punctuality, we will be introducing a reward system in term three for any classes who have zero late arrivals over a five week period. This will commence week one of term three.

We will also be allocating points to each house (O'reilly and Stinson) for attendance – every day you are at school you will receive a point for your house. These points will accumulate and
