This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English.
- Increase the percentage of Prep students able to read and comprehend short, predictable texts and compose and record short, meaningful sentences

Our initiatives include

- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data (using the inquiry cycle model), to inform targeted teaching
- use Early Start and literacy continua materials across Prep to Year 4 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress
- build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate and improve learning
- provide targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Actions	Costs
Increasing human resources to assist teachers in Reading Groups twice a week in two hour blocks. Teacher aides 4hrs by 6 for 31 weeks.	\$17 920
Continue with the online library program allowing access to the broader community libraries and online tutorials and resources.	\$ 3 500
Increase human resources in Prep classes as well as for our Pre Prep program in Semester Two.	\$ 5 000
Increase human resources in all classes to increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English.	\$16 300
Purchase of 10 ACER laptops as per the strategic ICT infrastructure plan.	\$ 8 000
Targeted professional development \$16 710 and related TRS \$13 860 (33 days)	\$18 070
