QPARENTS

QParents website allows parents of Queensland state school students to access information about their child and communicate directly with the school. You will have access to your child's reports, their absence details, any outstanding invoices you may have and positive behaviour records. The school will also be utilising Qparents for any student consent forms that need to be completed. Registration details will be emailed out to families this week. If you do not receive this email please contact the office to update your email details and your access codes will be emailed to you. Qparents also enables you to advise the school of upcoming absences and to provide 'explanations' for any unexplained absences. ORAL HEALTH SERVICES

ABSENCES

Any absence or late arrival must be reported to the office so it is recorded electronically. It is a courtesy to also let the teacher know, however teachers are unable to input the absence data.



For absence longer than 10 school days, parents/carers must complete an exemption application form. Please speak to school admin if you require one.

ATTENDANCE

Every day of learning counts at Woodhill State School, with our annual target being 95% attendance. Learners at or exceeding this target are our Attendance Champions. Every learner's attendance is monitored, including late arrivals, early departures and unexplained absences.

The class with the highest overall attendance percentage for each term will win a pizza party. Be here all day, every day to be in with a chance of winning.



BIKE PANTS

Our school uniform does not include bike pants. These may be worn **UNDER** shorts or skorts but not in replacement of the uniform.

QSCHOOLS APP

Qschools allows parents to receive notifications from the school as soon as they have been uploaded to the school website. Search for the app 'Qschools' and download to your mobile device. To receive automatic updates, you will need to ensure that Qschools push notifications are enabled on your device. Search for Woodhill State School and select it as a favourite.

COMPLAINTS PROCESS

If you have an issue regarding your child, your first point of contact is always with your child's teacher. Please contact the teacher via email to organize a scheduled appointment. If you are not satisfied with the outcome of this appointment then an appointment can be made to see the principal. If you have discussed your complaint with the principal and still feel that you have not reached a resolution, you have the right to contact your local Department of Education and Training office. STUDENT STATE SCHOOL CONSENT FORMS
